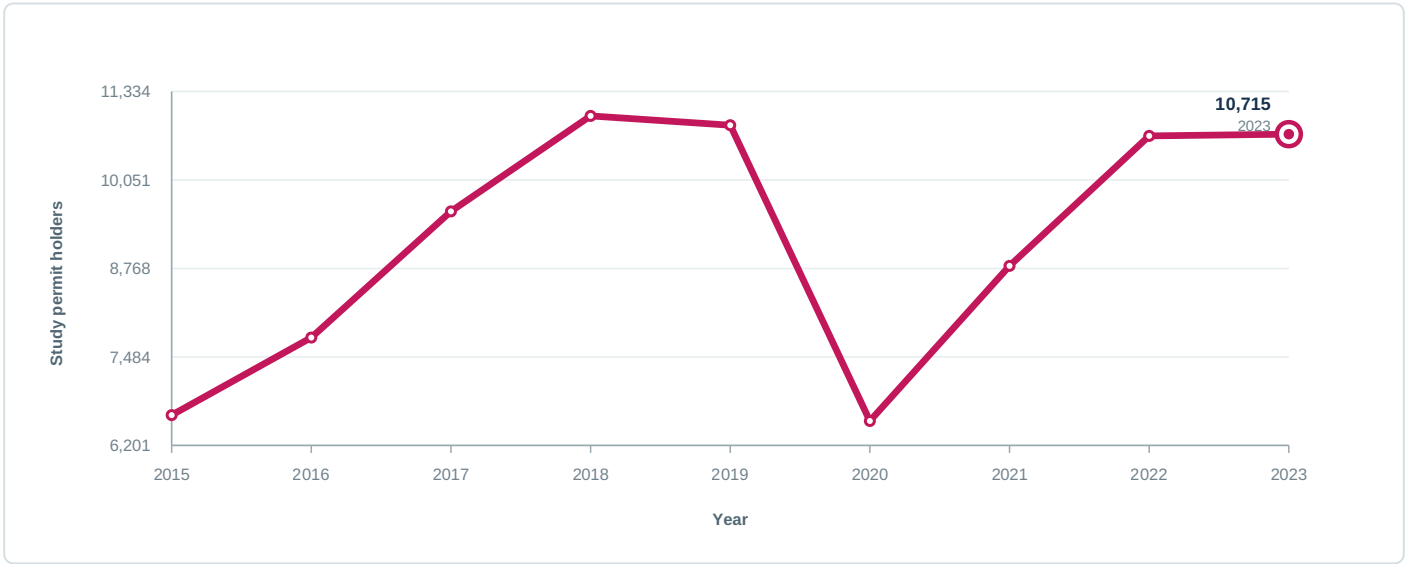

**Below historical peak**

Brazil had 2.4% fewer published study permit holders in 2023 than at its historical peak in 2018.

**Compared with historical average**

Brazil's 2023 published total is 16.8% above its historical average for complete years.
