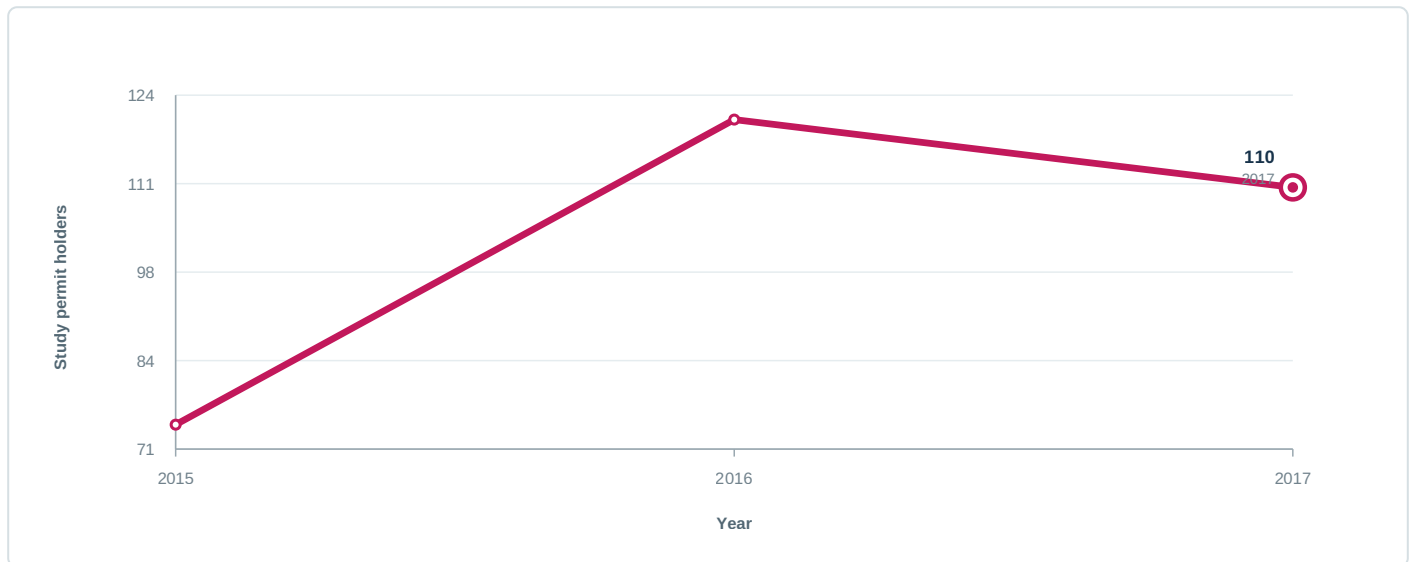

#### KEY INSIGHTS

### What the data shows

- Below historical peak**  
Palestinian Authority (Gaza/West Bank) had 8.3% fewer published study permit holders in 2017 than at its historical peak in 2016.
- Compared with historical average**  
Palestinian Authority (Gaza/West Bank)'s 2017 published total is 8.2% above its historical average for complete years.
