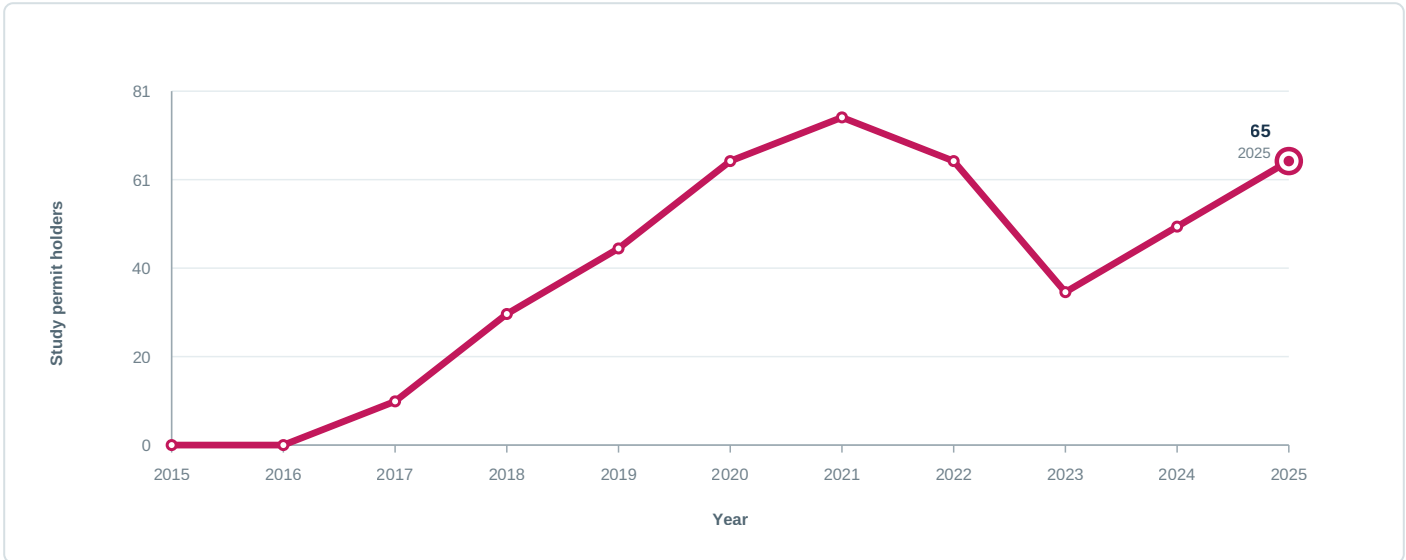

- Below historical peak**
Chartered Professional Accountants of British Columbia had 13.3% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2021.
- Compared with historical average**
Chartered Professional Accountants of British Columbia's 2025 published total is 26.8% above its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**
Chartered Professional Accountants of British Columbia ranks #6 among others in British Columbia for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Chartered Professional Accountants of British Columbia represents 1.3% of the published study permit-holder total among others in British Columbia in 2025.
