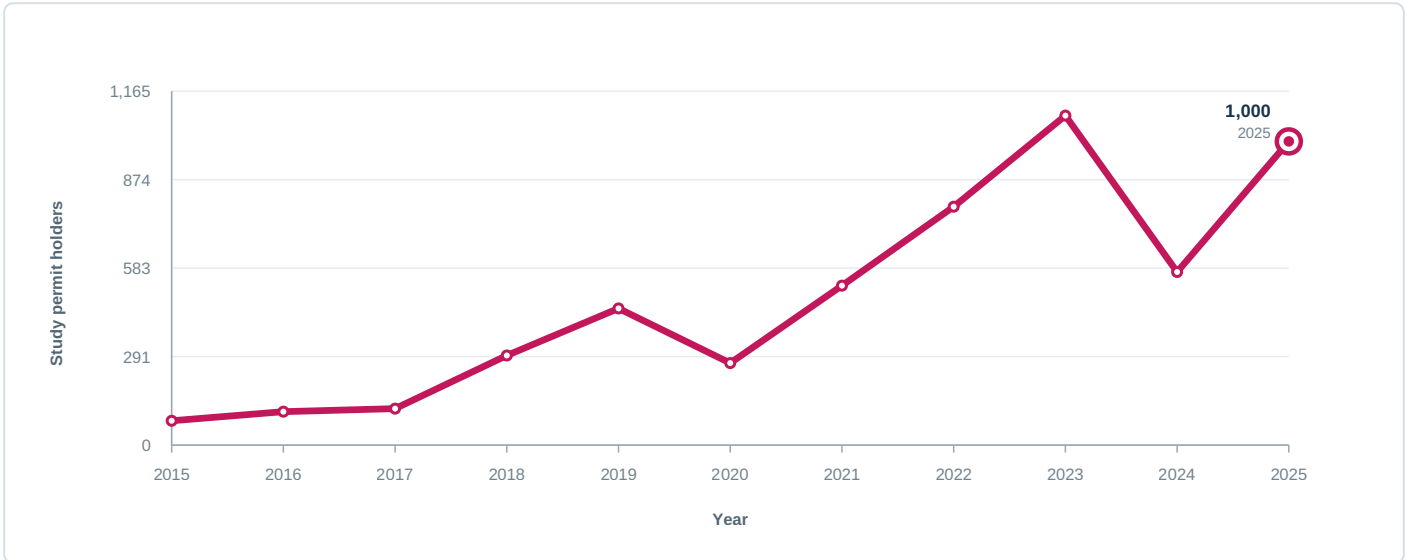

- Below historical peak**
Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick CCNB had 7.8% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2023.
- Compared with historical average**
Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick CCNB's 2025 published total is 91.9% above its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**
Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick CCNB ranks #2 among colleges in New Brunswick for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Collège communautaire du Nouveau-Brunswick CCNB represents 47.6% of the published study permit-holder total among colleges in New Brunswick in 2025.
