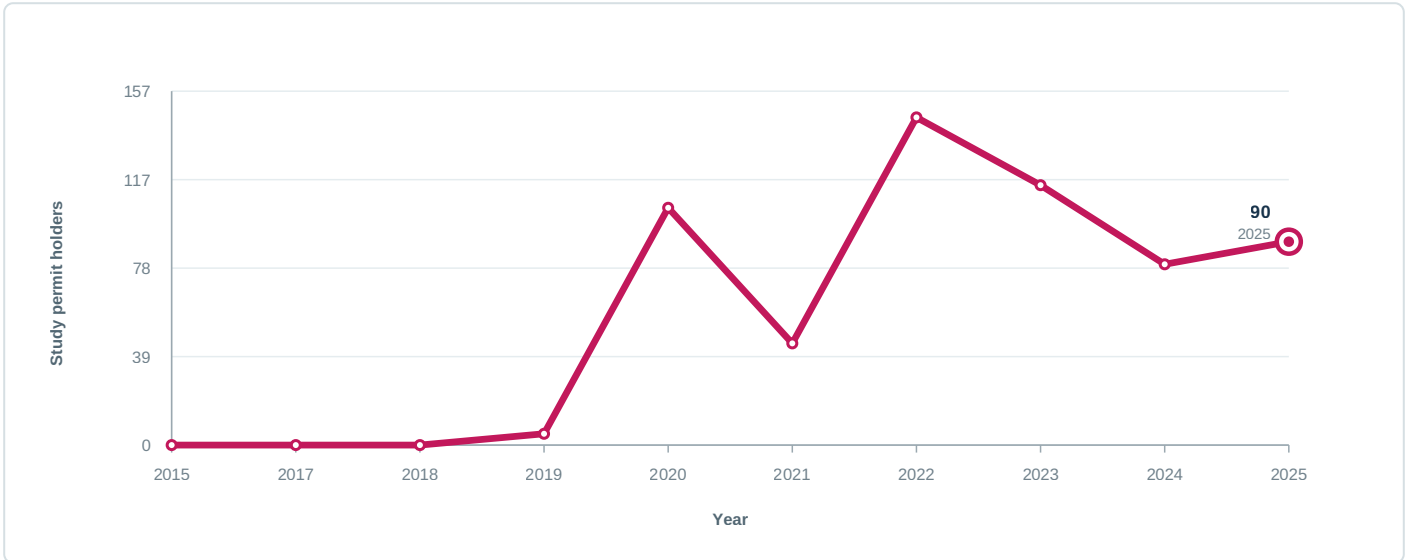

- Rank among comparable institutions**
 Collège Supérieur de Sherbrooke ranks #4 among others in Quebec for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
 Collège Supérieur de Sherbrooke represents 9.9% of the published study permit-holder total among others in Quebec in 2025.
