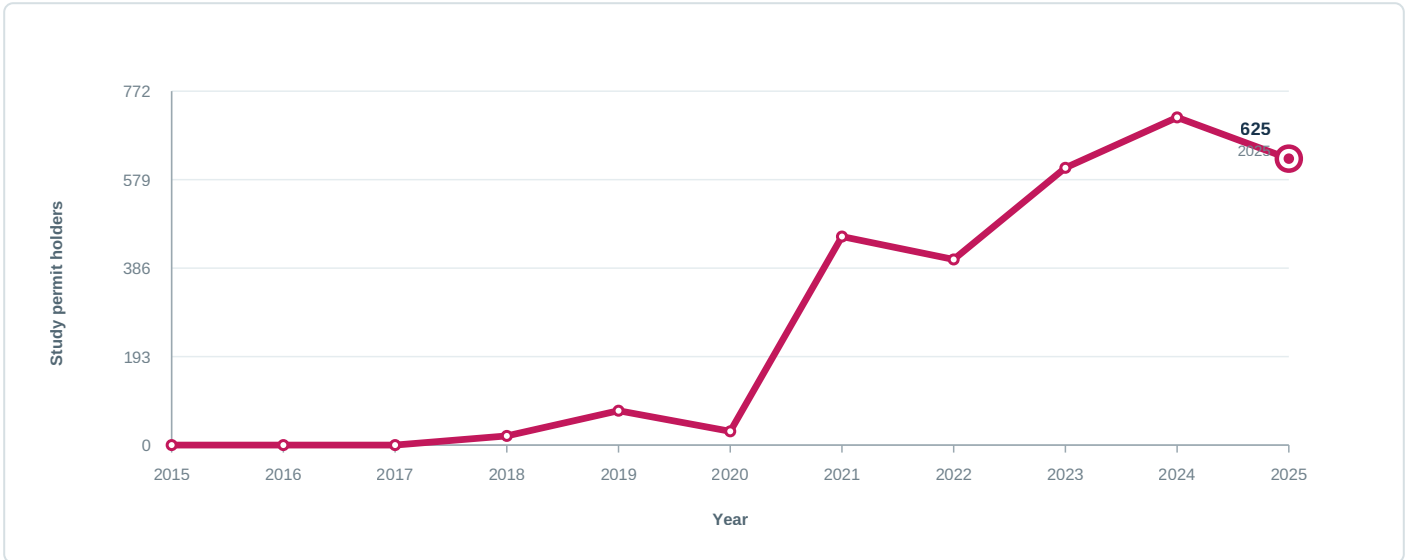

Crandall University ranks #3 among universities in New Brunswick for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Crandall University represents 22.0% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in New Brunswick in 2025.
