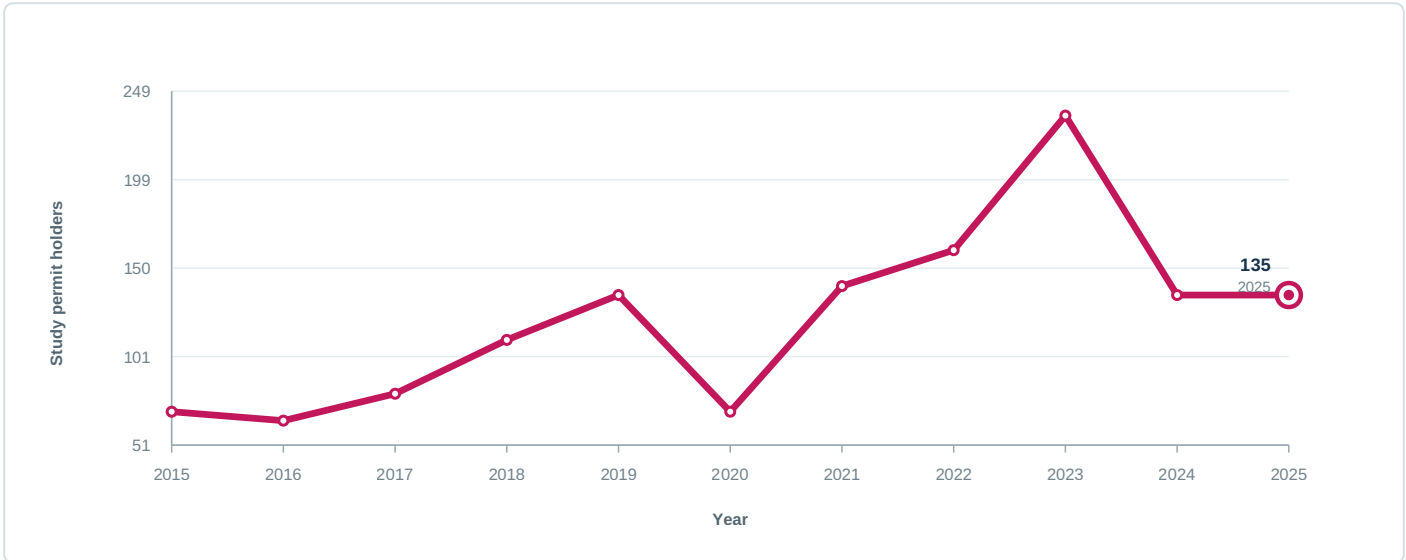

Mount Allison University ranks #4 among universities in New Brunswick for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Mount Allison University represents 4.8% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in New Brunswick in 2025.
