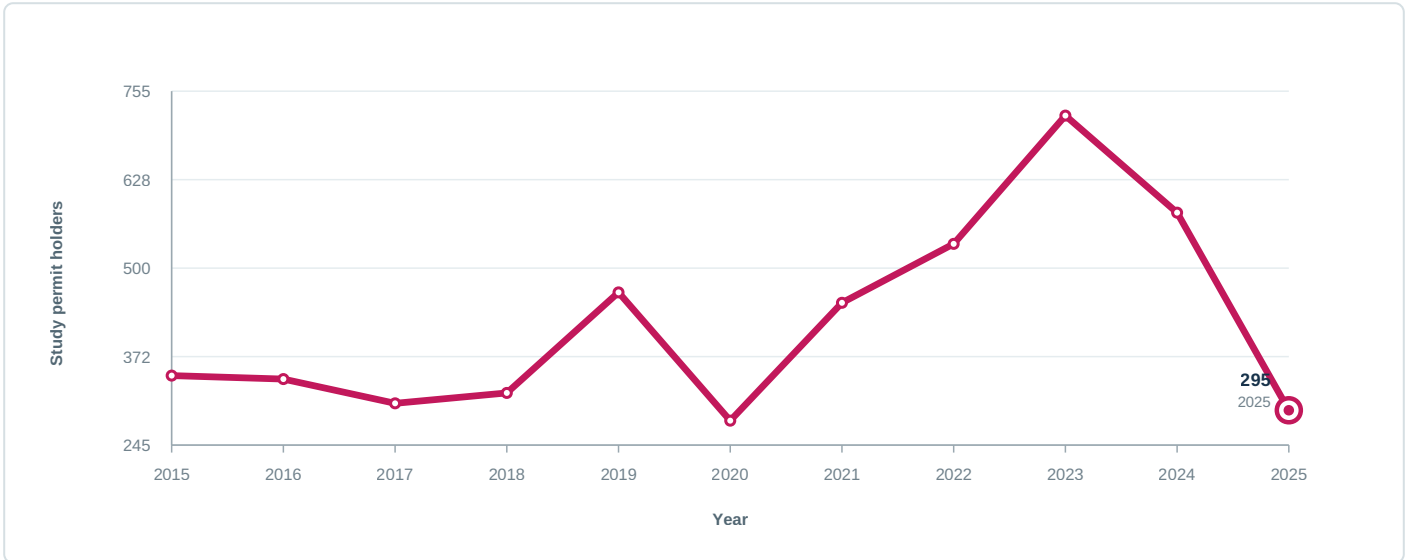

Mount Saint Vincent University ranks #4 among universities in Nova Scotia for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Mount Saint Vincent University represents 7.5% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in Nova Scotia in 2025.
