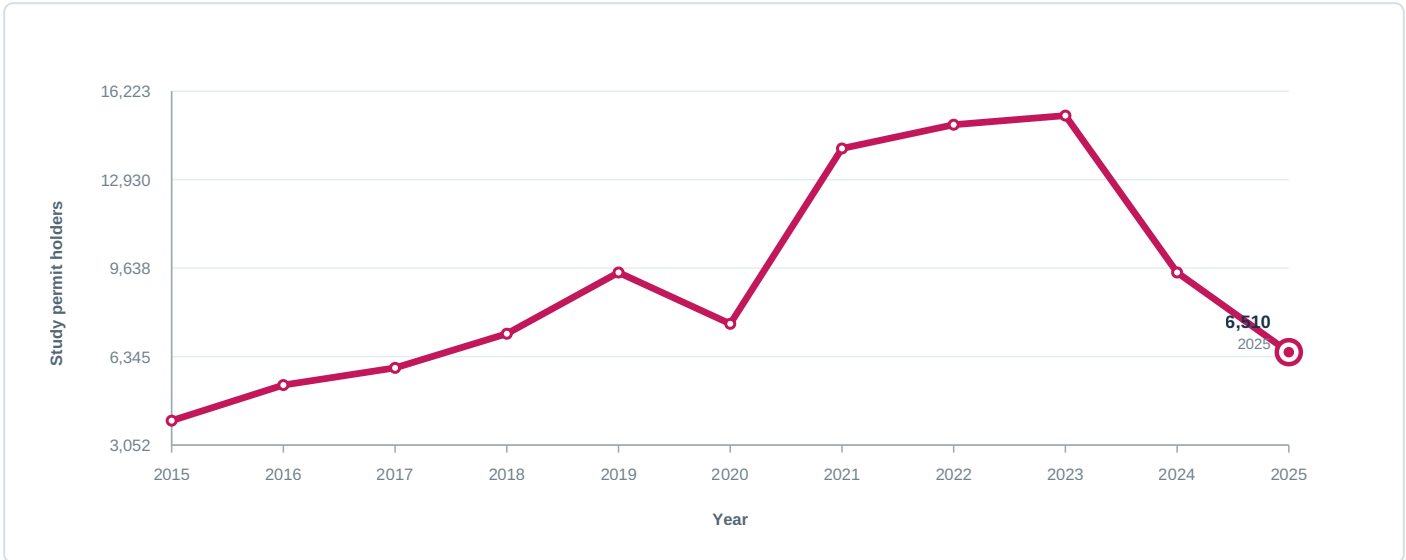

- 1 Below historical peak**
Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology had 57.5% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2023.
- 2 Compared with historical average**
Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology's 2025 published total is 28.2% below its historical average for complete years.
- 3 Rank among comparable institutions**
Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology ranks #2 among colleges in Ontario for 2025.
- 4 Share of comparable total**
Seneca College of Applied Arts and Technology represents 9.8% of the published study permit-holder total among colleges in Ontario in 2025.
