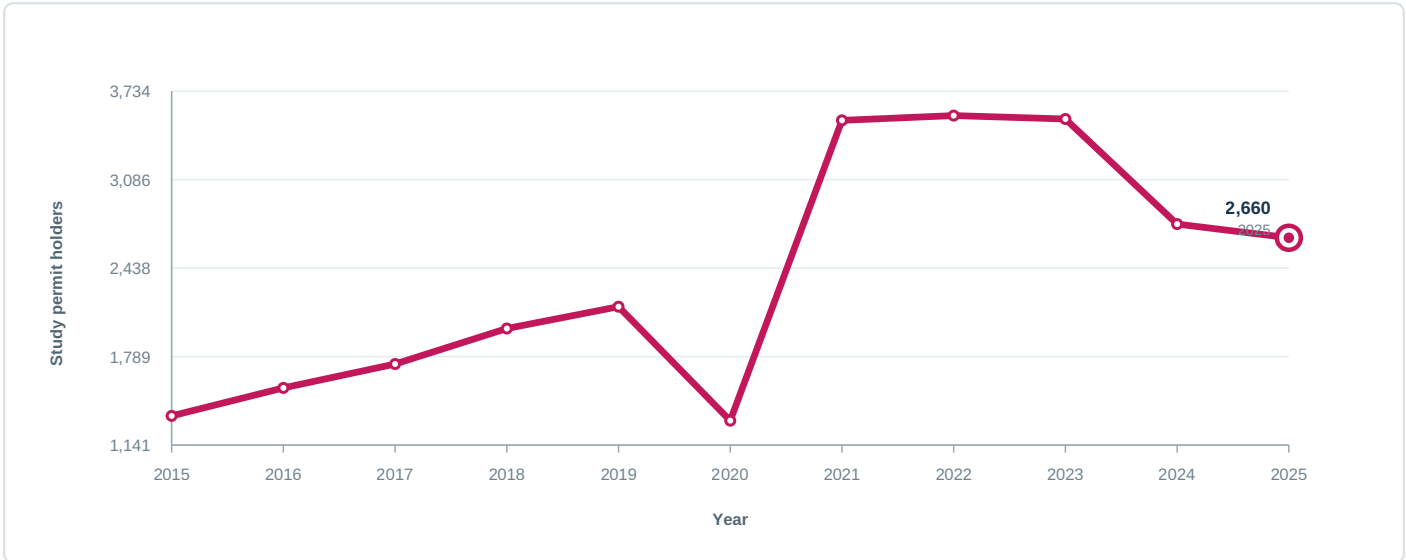

- Below historical peak**
University of Calgary had 25.2% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2022.
- Compared with historical average**
University of Calgary's 2025 published total is 11.9% above its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**
University of Calgary ranks #2 among universities in Alberta for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
University of Calgary represents 32.3% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in Alberta in 2025.
