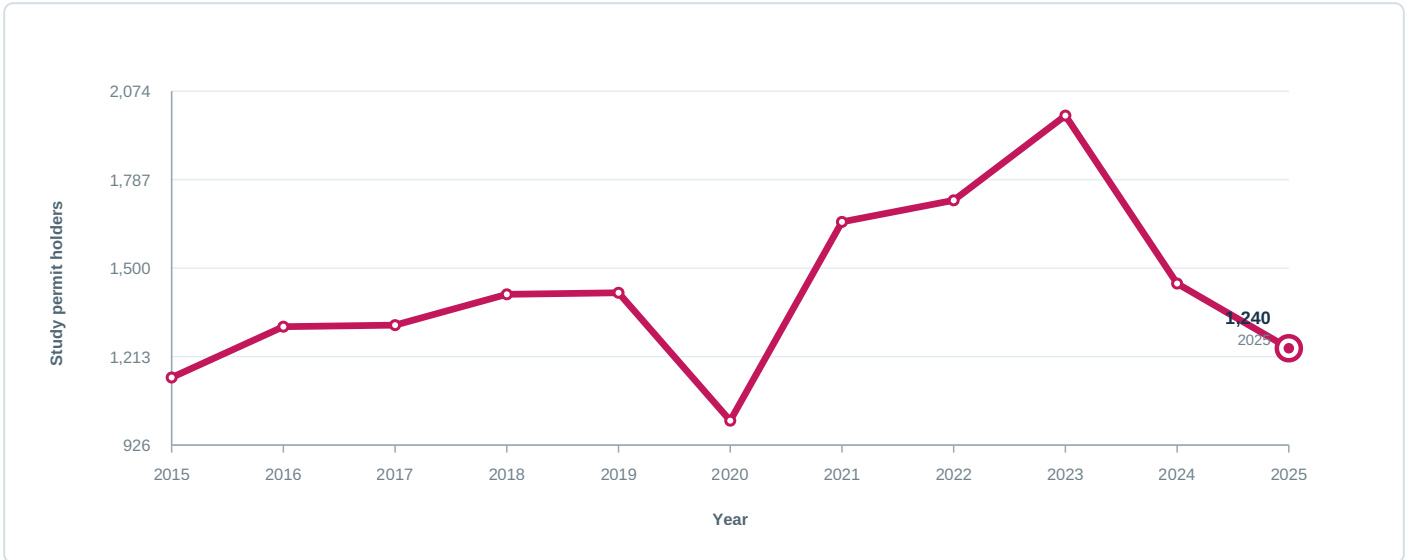

- Below historical peak**
University of Saskatchewan including St Thomas More College had 37.8% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2023.
- Compared with historical average**
University of Saskatchewan including St Thomas More College's 2025 published total is 12.9% below its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**
University of Saskatchewan including St Thomas More College ranks #2 among universities in Saskatchewan for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
University of Saskatchewan including St Thomas More College represents 44.8% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in Saskatchewan in 2025.
