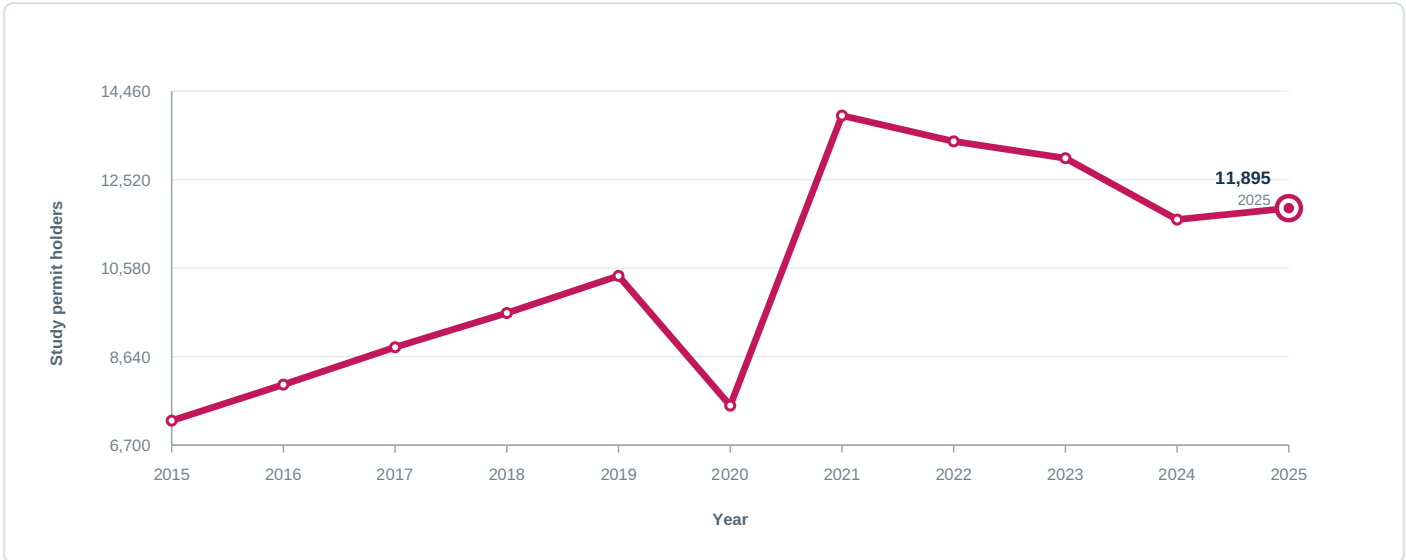

- Below historical peak**
University of Toronto had 14.6% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2021.
- Compared with historical average**
University of Toronto's 2025 published total is 13.3% above its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**
University of Toronto ranks #1 among universities in Ontario for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
University of Toronto represents 25.3% of the published study permit-holder total among universities in Ontario in 2025.
