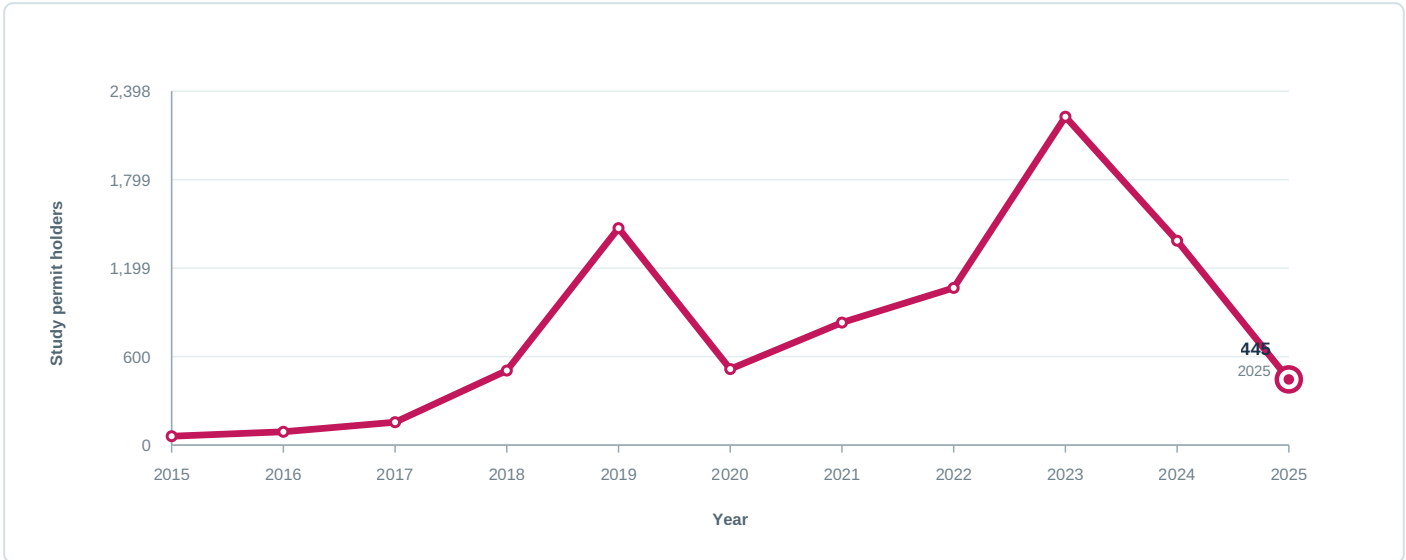

- Rank among comparable institutions**
Yorkville University - Toronto Film School ranks #2 among career colleges in Ontario for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**
Yorkville University - Toronto Film School represents 9.8% of the published study permit-holder total among career colleges in Ontario in 2025.
