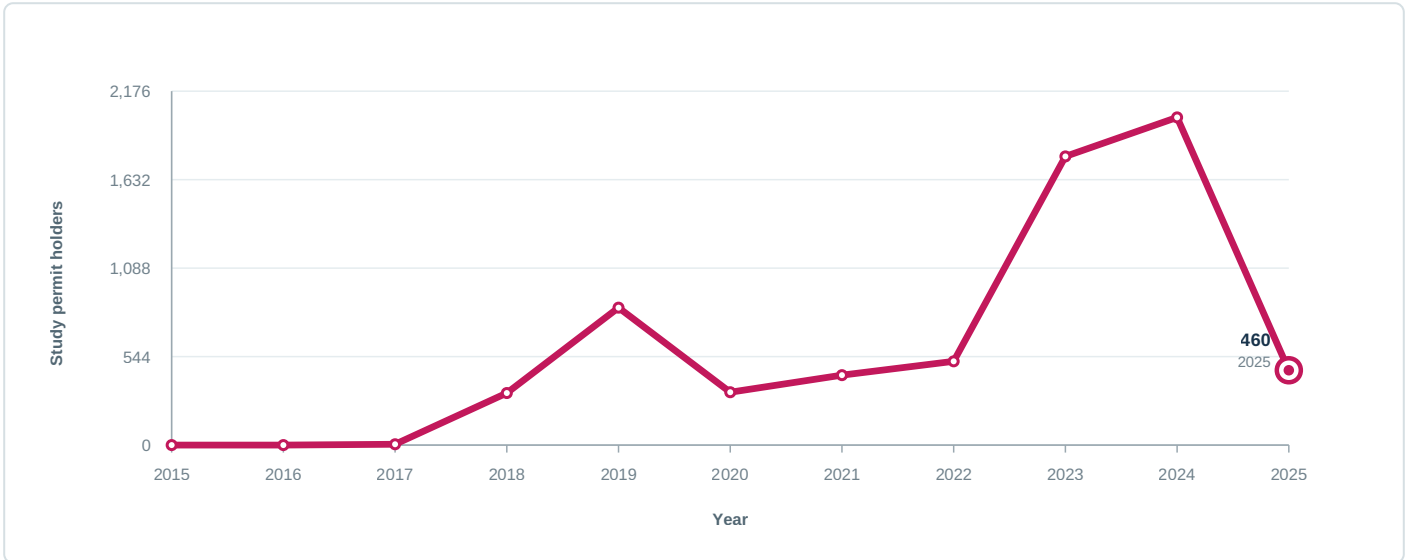

### What the data shows

- Below historical peak**  
Yorkville University had 77.2% fewer published study permit holders in 2025 than at its historical peak in 2024.
- Compared with historical average**  
Yorkville University's 2025 published total is 45.0% below its historical average for complete years.
- Rank among comparable institutions**  
Yorkville University ranks #3 among others in British Columbia for 2025.
- Share of comparable total**  
Yorkville University represents 9.5% of the published study permit-holder total among others in British Columbia in 2025.
